


Co-Product Feeds in Europe

This new book is more extensive than the earlier one and it includes both feeds that are imported into Europe as well as those that are produced here. Its wider scope embraces feeds for aquaculture and those arising from additional processes such as the production of biofuels, fish and land animal processing as well as the fractionation of legume and oil seeds.

“Co-products Feeds” was an essential reference for the upgrade of the EU Catalogue of feed materials. With its co-products brochure edited in 2019, FEFAC illustrated via a few examples how important the contribution of co-products as raw material for animal feed was to the implementation of a circular economy. Co-products Feeds in Europe 2020 goes a step further in providing an almost exhaustive overview of the many types of co-products that are usable as feed.
