A journey in continuous sustainability improvement

- **2016 – IDH supports FEFAC and ITC**
 - Development of FEFAC's first Soy Sourcing Guidelines
- **2018 – FEFAC, FEDIOL and IDH agree on cooperation**
 - Advance sustainability in soy supply chains in Mato Grosso, Brazil
- **2020 – IDH supports FEFAC with the SSG 2021**
 - Next: Partnership with local Farmers for true sustainability solutions
- **2021/2025 – Need for Action**
 - Supply Chain Actors: Take joint action to trigger real transformation
 - Create: lasting impact with continuous improvement and investment
 - Join: Landscape approach for inclusion of mainstream markets



IDH Landscape Approach tot Sustainability

Progressive insight to inclusive action

- **2008 - Started work in Soya Supply Chains**
 - Supported RTRS in its certification development
- **2015 - Progressed to Landscape Approach development**
 - Based on continuous improvement principles
 - Created powerful Production, Protection and Inclusion (PPI) approach
- **2021 - Implement Supply Chain Cooperation: SourceUp**
 - Online platform for companies in agri supply chain and producing regions
 - To align sustainability goals and actions for true impact
 - SourceUp creates positive sustainability impact at landscape level
 - Helps companies deliver on corporate sustainability commitments
