


Four Goals:

1. Accelerate efforts to remove commodity-driven deforestation from **individual supply chains**.
2. Set higher expectations for **suppliers and traders** to act across their entire supply base and find opportunities for **collaboration and alignment** to drive sector-wide transformation.
3. Drive transformational change in key commodity **landscapes**.
4. Define measurable outcomes on which all members agree to **track and report** individually and collectively.



Coalition Structure




The Soy Roadmap (launched in Nov 2020 on the [CGF website](#))



Key commitments:

- Accelerate efforts to eliminate **legal and illegal** soy-driven deforestation and conversion of natural ecosystems from our individual supply chains, adopting sectoral **cut-off dates** where they exist and a cut-off date no later than 2020 for the rest;
- Set higher expectations for **suppliers and traders** to act across their entire supply base and find opportunities for **collaboration and alignment** to drive sector-wide transformation
- Do business with suppliers who are also committed to Forest Positive implementation **across their business**
- Drive transformational change in key **soy producing landscapes** through positive engagement in high-risk origins (initial geographic scope to include Cerrado in Brazil and Gran Chaco in Paraguay and Argentina)
- Transparently **report on progress** to ensure accountability.



Implementing the Soy Roadmap



Key collective actions for 2021:

- **Element 1:** Update the CGF Soy Sourcing Guidelines
- **Element 2:** Engage with traders and suppliers, including communicating the expectations and tracking performance, and identifying areas for collaboration to drive sector-wide transformation
- **Element 3:** Build and strengthen a shared understanding of high-risk origins in collaboration with key stakeholders
- **Element 4:** Begin implementation of landscape engagement plan
- **Element 5:** KPI reporting starting in Q1 2021
